



## Southeast Diamondbacks Little League Tee Ball Division Rules

1. Games will be played primarily on the Football Field. Every effort will be made to play some games on the baseball fields.
2. Bases are to be set at 60ft. Pitcher position is roughly 36 feet from home plate. Please bring a tape measure or use a 60ft. string to measure.
3. Tee Ball division will use the "SOFT" type baseballs only.
4. Both teams are responsible for setting up the field. Whoever gets there first should begin setting up.
5. All defensive players may be used in the field. No player shall sit out.
6. There is NO catcher in the Tee-ball division.
7. EVERY batter must wear a helmet.
8. Have players sit in their batting order on carpet squares, mats, on a bucket, etc.
9. NO on deck batters! No warm-up swings or hitting sticks, etc. **This is a Little League rule.**
10. Players should stay in their spot until it is their turn to bat.
11. HOME team will sit along the third base line and VISITORS will sit along the first base line
12. No score will be kept.
13. An offensive half inning ENDS when the offensive team has batted their entire roster. The last batter gets to run all the bases, so change up your batting order each game.
14. NO sliding!!!
15. Defense: Assign 3 coaches/parent volunteers to different zones in the field to help players stay in their zone. The more parent volunteers the better.
16. Move players around each inning so they can play a variety of positions.
17. Game time shall not exceed one hour.
18. Games should not be forfeited due to lack of players. Just play with the number of players you have.
19. There is NO end of season tournament in Tee-ball. All players will receive a participation trophy or medal at the end of the season.
20. Tee-ball is designed to provide the foundation and introduction of baseball.

**\*SEDLL Tee-ball goals for 4-6 year old's: learning to listen to a coach, following directions, being part of a team and most of all having fun! Keep the kids moving and active!**
